【授業目標・到達目標】

この授業は海外で1年間留学する予定者のための準備講座である。現地事情の説明や海外留学の注意事項の説明を通じて、現地で生活する際に必要な情報とコミュニケーション能力の向上を授業目標とする。また、受講者が様々なトレーニングや留学生との交流を通して、自分とは異なる文化が存在することを認識し、カルチャーショックの対処法を身につけることができ、その上でどのような心と態度で異文化を受け入れていけばいいのかを学ぶことができる。なお、以下の内容は学生に選ばれた留学先によって異なっている。

【履修注意】

This class will increase students' awareness and understanding of America and of the host universities in America as well as the internship program in Australia. We will review important details such as the application: the I-20 document, the F-1 visa issuance process, safety issues, pre-departure planning, and other important procedures and matters of importance for study in America and taking part in the internship program in Australia. Students will be expected to bring paper, writing instruments, a computer, and a dictionary. Students must not miss any of these lectures to receive credit for the class.
